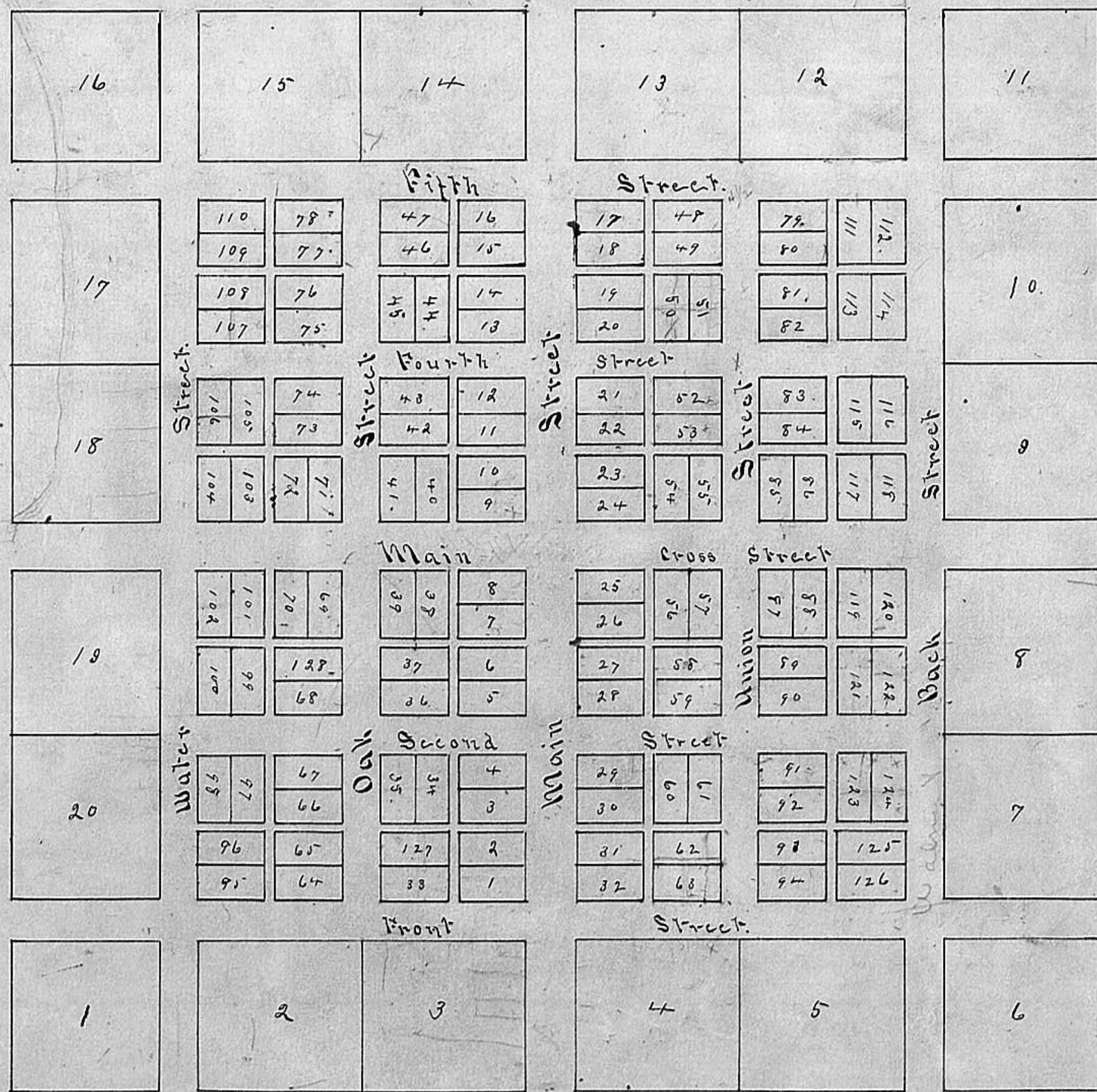

Main Street and the Streets and alleys parallel thereto runs North. Forty five west. The other Streets and alleys are at right angles thereto being South. Forty five degrees west. Main Street and Main Cross Street are six poles wide, all the other Streets are four and one half poles wide and the alleys are all one pole wide. All the In Lots are four poles front and eight poles back and Lot No 9 is reserved for the Court House. No 10 for the Jail. No 75 and 91 for Churches and Academies.

The out Lots contain two acres and upwards of ground. Out Lot No 11 is reserved for burying ground, and No 19 for John Murfin, and that all Streets and allies are for the use of the Public.
