

## Midway


Town Plat of Midway Recorded July 13<sup>th</sup> 1833.


The above is a plat of Midway laid out by William Holt, William Morris and John M. Blue situated in Madison County Ohio, including part of Survey No. lying and binding on the north side of the Federal road, and one half of the lots on the west side and one half on the east side of the road leading from London to Washington. Main Street runs N 2° W. (and at right angles with said Federal Road which runs S. 88° W and is 66 feet in width. North, West and East Streets 60 feet in width, alleys 16 1/2 feet in width, all the lots 66 feet in front and 132 feet back except No 23 & 24 which is but 66 feet square, lots parallel to and with the streets and alleys. The survey of said town is predicated on the southeast corner stone of John M. Blue large frame house, which is placed at the southeast corner of Lot No One. Lots numbered from 1 to 26 in regular progression.

I hereby certify that the above plat is a correct representation of the Town of Midway as surveyed by me on the 27 day of December 1832.
