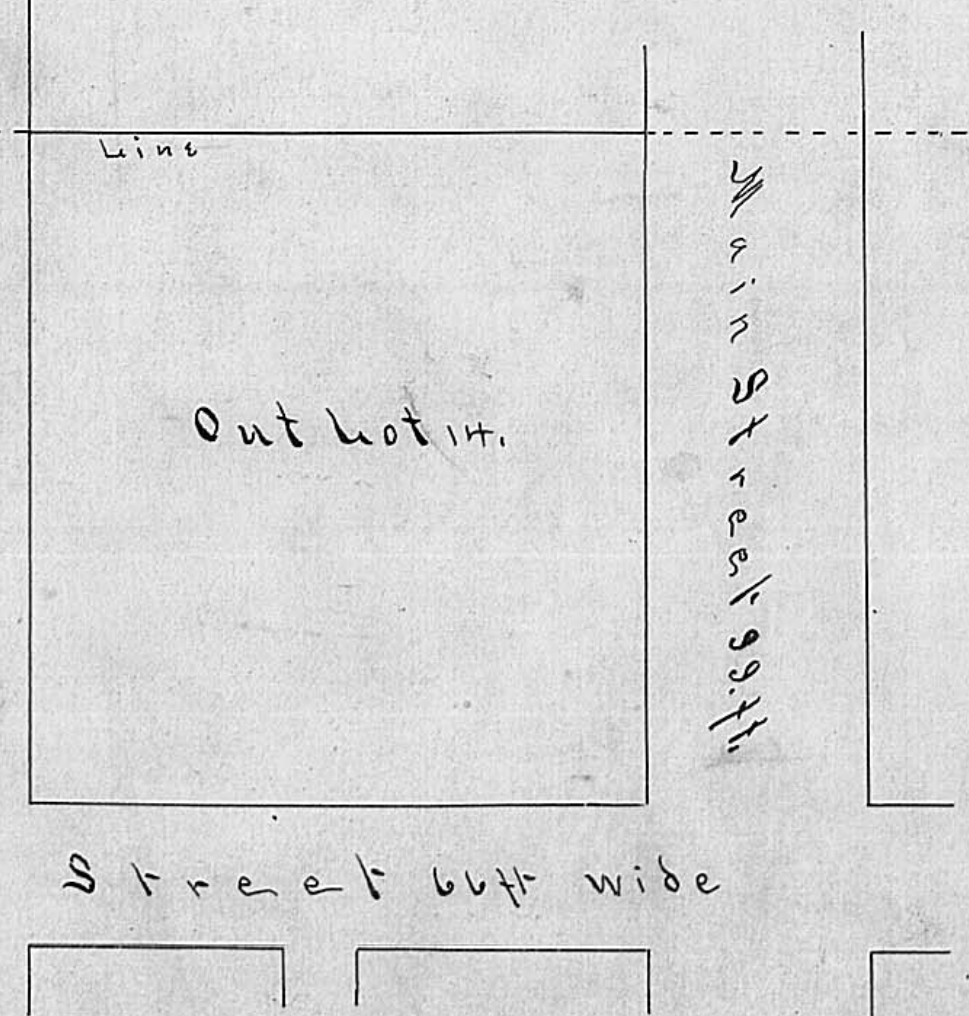

London. J. Q. Minshall's Addition

J. Q. Minshall's addition to the town of London is predicated upon a store at a (see Plat) of the Thomas and Willis addition to said Town of London. In Lots 1 and 23 are based upon the S. E. line of the S. E. Street of said Thomas and Willis Addition. The center line of Oak and Water Streets of the Minshall's addition coincide with the center lines of the same in the Thomas and Willis addition. In Lots Nos 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, and 23, are each 66 feet in width by 132 feet in depth. In Lots Nos 9, 10, 14 and 15 are each 66 ft in width, 120 ft in depth. In Lots No 11, and 12 are each 66 ft in width and 97 ft in depth. Lot No 13 is 132 ft on Fifth Street by 97 feet in depth. Oak and Water Streets are each 66 ft wide. Main Street is 99 feet wide. The Streets between In Lots Nos 4, 5, 19, 7 and 20 and 8, 9, 10, 14, 15, 7 16 are each 30 feet wide all alleys are 16 1/2 feet wide.

Know all men by these Presents, That James D. Minshall and Lydia Minshall his wife have adopted the above plat and description of Lots and Streets and alleys caused to be laid off, by said James D. Minshall under the name of, James D. Minshall's Addition to the town of London, in said County of Madison and numbered the same for record in the proper office in dedicating to public use the Streets and Alleys therein set forth and acknowledged the same to be their free act and deed for the uses and purposes therein set forth.
