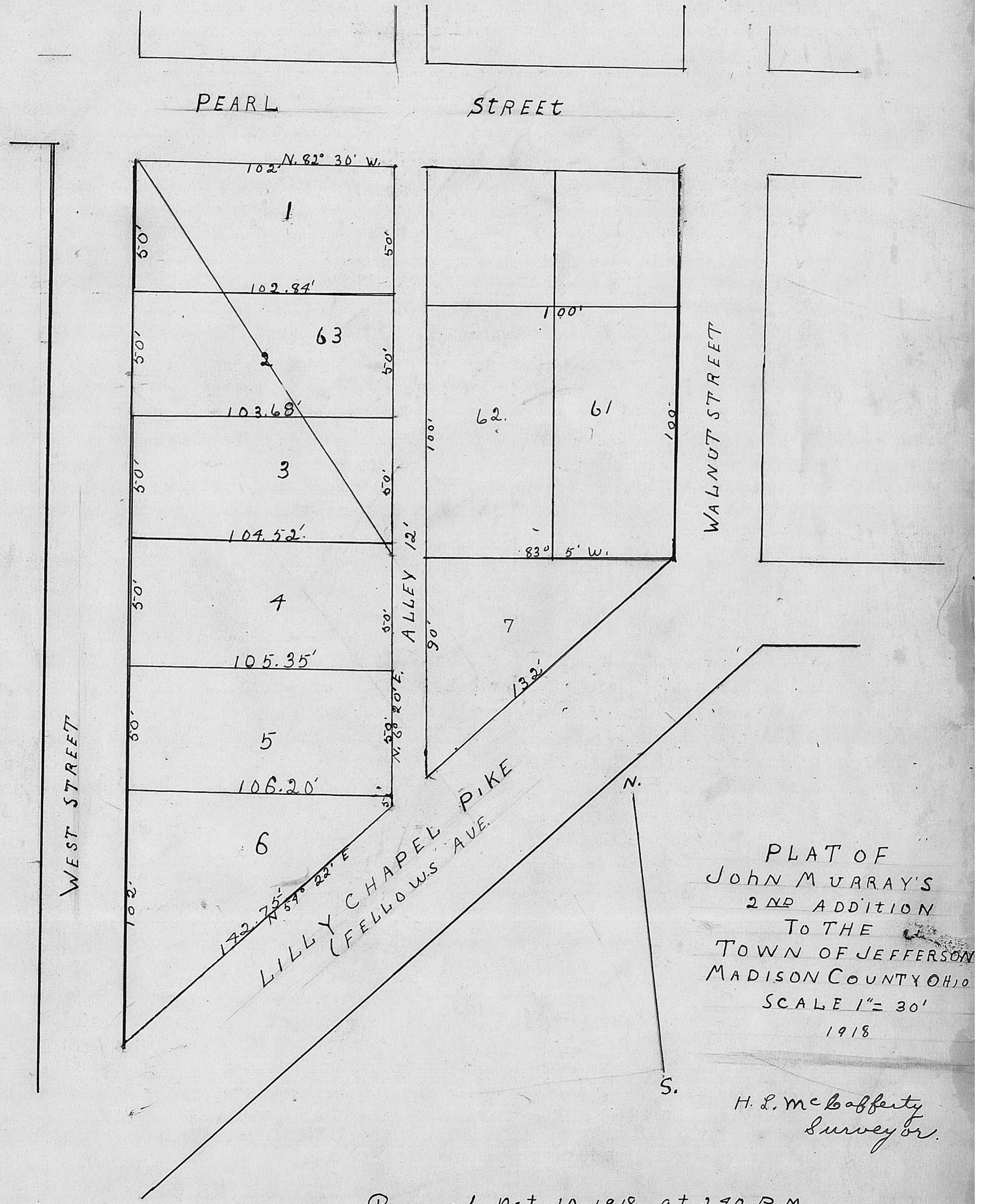

I hereby certify that I have made a survey of John Murrays second addition to the town of Jefferson, Madison County Ohio, and have staked the same into lots streets and alleys as shown by the attached plat and that said plat is a correct representation of said survey, the following are correct descriptions of the lots included in said addition:

Lot No. 1: Beginning at a stone at the south easterly corner of Pearl and West streets, thence with the east line of West street S. $7^{\circ} 2' W$. 50 feet; thence S. $82^{\circ} 30' E$. 102.84 feet to the west line of a 12 foot alley, thence with said line N. $6^{\circ} 20' E$. 50 feet to the intersection of said alley line with the south line of Pearl street; thence with said line of Pearl street N. $82^{\circ} 30' W$. 102 feet to the beginning, containing 5120 square feet, of which 4270 square feet are a part of lot No 63, of Isaac Jones' addition to the town of Jefferson;

Lot No. 2: Beginning at a stake in the east line of West street South west corner to lot No 1 in John Murrays 2nd addition to the town of Jefferson, thence with said line S. $7^{\circ} 2' W$. 50 feet; thence S. $82^{\circ} 30' E$. 103.68 feet to the west line of a 12 foot alley; thence with said line N. $6^{\circ} 20' E$. 50 feet to the south east corner of said lot No 1, thence N. $82^{\circ} 30' W$. 102.84 feet to the beginning, containing 5160 square feet, of which 2610 square feet are a part of lot No 63 of Isaac Jones' addition to the town of Jefferson.

Lot No. 3: Beginning at a stake in the east line of West street South west corner to lot No 2 in John Murrays 2nd addition to the town of Jefferson; thence with said line S. $7^{\circ} 2' W$. 50 feet; thence S. $82^{\circ} 30' E$. 104.52 feet to the west line of a 12 foot alley; thence with said line N. $6^{\circ} 20' E$. 50 feet to the south east corner of said lot No 2, thence N. $82^{\circ} 30' W$. 103.68 feet to the beginning, containing 5200 square feet, of which 990 square feet are a part of lot No. 63 of Isaac Jones' addition to the town of Jefferson.

Lot No. 4: Beginning at a stake in the east line of West street South west corner to lot No 3, in John Murrays 2nd addition to the town of Jefferson; thence with said line S. $7^{\circ} 2' W$. 50 feet; thence S. $82^{\circ} 30' E$. 105.35 feet to the west line of a 12 foot alley, thence with said line N. $6^{\circ} 20' E$. 50 feet to the south east corner of said lot No 3, thence N. $82^{\circ} 30' W$. 104.52 feet to the beginning; containing 5240 square feet of which 5 square feet are a part of lot No 63 of Isaac Jones' addition to the town of Jefferson.

Lot No 5: Beginning at a stake in the east line of West street, South west corner to lot No 4 in John Murrays 2nd addition to the town of Jefferson; thence S. $7^{\circ} 2' W$. 50 feet; thence S. $82^{\circ} 30' E$. 106.20 feet to the west line of a 12 foot alley; thence with said line N. $6^{\circ} 20' E$ 50 feet to the south east corner to said lot No. 4, thence N. $82^{\circ} 30' W$. 105.35 feet to the beginning, containing 5280 square feet

Lot No. 6: Beginning at a stake in the east line of West street South west corner to lot No 5 in John Murrays 2nd addition to the town of Jefferson thence with said line South $7^{\circ} 2' W$. 102 feet to the north westerly line of the Lilly chapel pike, thence with said line N. $54^{\circ} 22' E$ 142.75 feet to a stake at the junction of the west line of a 12 foot alley with said line of the Lilly chapel pike; thence with said alley line N. $6^{\circ} 20' E$. 5 feet to the south east corner of said lot No 5, thence N. $82^{\circ} 30' W$. 106.20 feet to the beginning containing 5630 square feet;

Lot No. 7: Beginning at a point south east corner to lot No. 61 of Isaac Jones' addition to the town of Jefferson at the junction of the West line of Walnut street with the north westerly line of the Lilly Chapel pike (sometimes called Fellows Avenue) thence with the south line of lots Nos. 61 and 62 N. $83^{\circ} 5' W$. 100 feet to the east line of a 12 foot alley; thence with said alley line S $6^{\circ} 20' W$. 90 feet to the junction of said alley line with said line of said pike; thence with said Pike line N. $54^{\circ} 22' E$. 132 feet to the beginning, containing 4500 square feet, of which 3300 square feet are a part of South street in the town of Jefferson which was ordered vacated by the Council of the Village of Jefferson by an Ordinance No 139 passed May 21-1904 and exchanged to John Murray for other property, now used for alley purposes
