Mortimore &amp; Newman's Addition

Second West addition to the town of Jefferson by Mortimore and Newman. Main Street same course and width as in first addition. Hampton Street and London Street are 33 feet in width. West and Hill Streets are 25 feet in width alley 12 feet in width. Pearl Street is 33 feet in width Streets and alleys runs parallel or at right angles with main street. all the lots are 50 feet in front and 150 feet deep.
