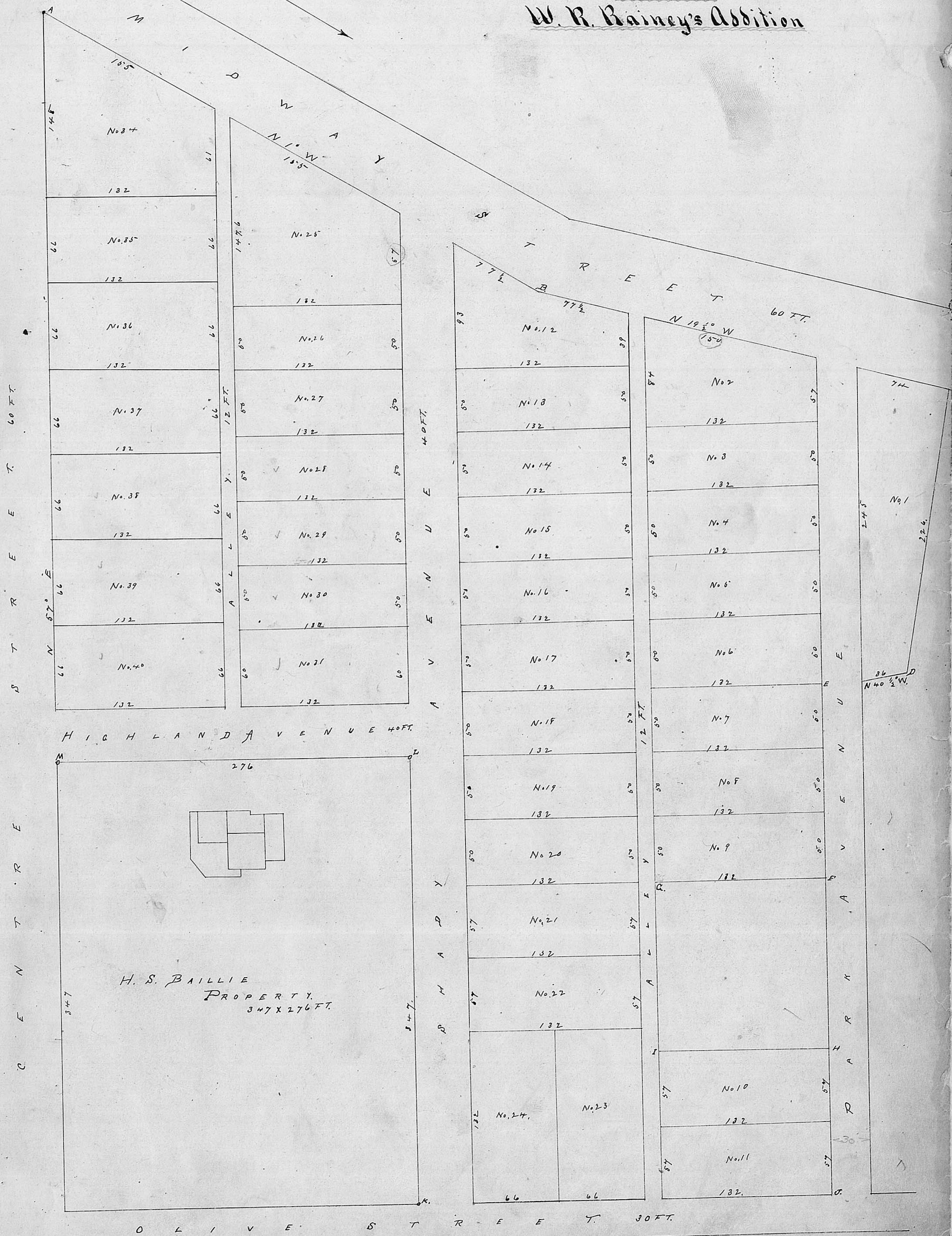

W R Rainey's Addition

Wm Rainey's 1st Addition To the village of London Ohio.

The survey from which the above Plat is made is based upon the points marked by stakes and indicated on the Plat by the red letters A. B. C. D. E. F. G. H. I. J. K. L. M.

The above named addition comprises the area designated by the above named letters and is a part of the Land purchased by Wm R. Rainey from Thomas Farrar and wife by deed dated Sept 12th 1891. and Recorded in Vol 53 page 494.

The position of the Lots, Alleys and Streets, names of Streets, widths of Streets and alleys, numbers of Lots and length of Lot lines are indicated on the above Plat, as follows. Park ave is thirty feet wide and extends from Olive St parallel with Center St and intersects with Midway Pike. Shady ave runs parallel with Center St from Olive St to the Midway Pike and is forty feet wide. Highland Ave runs parallel with Olive St at right angles from Center St and intersects with Shady ave. and is forty feet wide. All Alleys are twelve feet in width and their positions are indicated in the above Plat. Lots Nos 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30 are one hundred and thirty two feet in length and fifty feet in width. Lots Nos. 23, 24, 35, 36, 37, 38, 39, 40 are one hundred and thirty two feet in length and sixty six feet in width. Lots nos 10, 11, 21, 22, are one hundred and thirty two feet in length and fifty seven feet in width. Lot No 31 is one hundred and thirty two feet in length and sixty feet in width. Lots no 1, 2, 12, 25, 34, are irregular shapes and are described below.

Rainey his wife of London Ohio in the County of Madison and State of Ohio have adopted the foregoing plan and description of Lots, Streets and alleys caused to be laid out by them under the name of Rainey's First addition to the village of London in said County of Madison and State of Ohio and submitted the same for record in the proper office.
