

Exhibit A. Describes the Area in the Riddle Addition to London.

Explanations: The Riddle Addition to the Town of London Ohio. Consists of the territory embraced on the within Map, by the Letters a. b. c. d. e. f. g. h. i. j. k and l, and is predicated upon two stones planted in the center line of 5th street. One at M at intersection of W line of Elm St. and one at N, where center line of 5th st makes and angle to left of 49° 40'. The distance between the crosses on the sumits of these stones is 442 ft. The distance from M. with center line of 5th st to W line of A. C. K. d. the 14 ft alley is 185.7 ft. Fifth st from west line of Elm st. to stone at N is 50 ft wide and from N to Walnut st is 62 ft wide. Elm st is 60 ft wide. Riddle Avenue and Columbia st are each 45 ft wide. The alley a. C. K. d is 14 ft wide. The alley d. e. f is 12 ft wide. The alley from f to 5th st is a bay alley 8 1/2 ft wide. All other alleys are 16 1/2 ft wide. Lots Nos 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 15, 17, 18, 23, 24, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 32, 33, 34, and 35, are each 66 ft fronting 132 ft backs. The following lots are irregular and the dimensions of each are given below. The letters N. S. E. W. mean North, South, East and West.
