

Liverpool

A Town laid out by Darius Burnham on part of Survey No. in Madison County, Pike Township. Main Street runs North 49 East. Cross Street runs South 41 East. Alleys one pole wide. Streets 4 poles wide. A stone of about 100^{lb} weight has been placed at the Northwest corner of lot No 1. Said stone is South 61° E 14 1/10 poles from the Southeast corner of a School house. Lot No 14 begins at a stake North 41° W. 4 poles from said stone, running from thence with Cross Street N 41 W 13 3/10 poles, thence with a line of Fullingtons land N 34 E 4 1/10 poles thence S 41 E 14 3/10 poles to main street, and with the same S 49 W 4 poles to the beginning and containing 55 7/10 poles. Lot No 13, begins at the northeast corner of Lot No 14, runs thence with the same N 41 W 14 3/10 poles, thence N 34 E 4 1/10 poles; thence S 41 E 15 3/10 poles with an alley to main street and with the same S 49 W 4 poles to the beginning containing 61 7/10 poles. No 12 Beginning at a stake 1 pole S 49 E from the northeast corner of No 13 runs thence with an alley N 41 W 16 poles thence N 34 E 4 1/10 poles; thence S 41 E 17 3/10 poles to main street and with the same to the beginning containing 67 7/10 poles. No 11 begins at the northwest corner of No 12 runs thence with the same N 41 W 17 3/10 poles; thence N 34 E 4 1/10 poles; thence with an alley S 41 E 18 3/10 poles to main street and with same to the beginning, containing 73 3/10 poles. No 10 begins one pole S 49 E from the northeast of No 11 runs from thence with an alley N 41 W 19 poles, thence N 34 E 4 1/10 poles. thence S 49 E 20 poles to main street and with the same to the beginning containing 78 poles. No 9 begins at the northwest corner of No 10 runs with the same N 41 W 20 poles, thence N 34 E 2 3/10 poles to a bar oak; thence S 59 E 22 poles to main street and with the same 8 poles to the beginning containing 101 7/10 poles. The northeast corner of Lot No 15 is S 49 W 4 poles from the stone aforesaid. No 15 to 20 inclusive fronts 4 poles on cross street and runs 10 poles back; No 1 to 8 inclusive fronts 4 poles on main street and runs 10 1/2 poles back. I hereby certify that the above plat is a correct representation of the said Town of Liverpool, and that the description of the streets Alleys and lots are also correct and that the stone hereinbefore mentioned was placed by my direction May 18th 1836.
