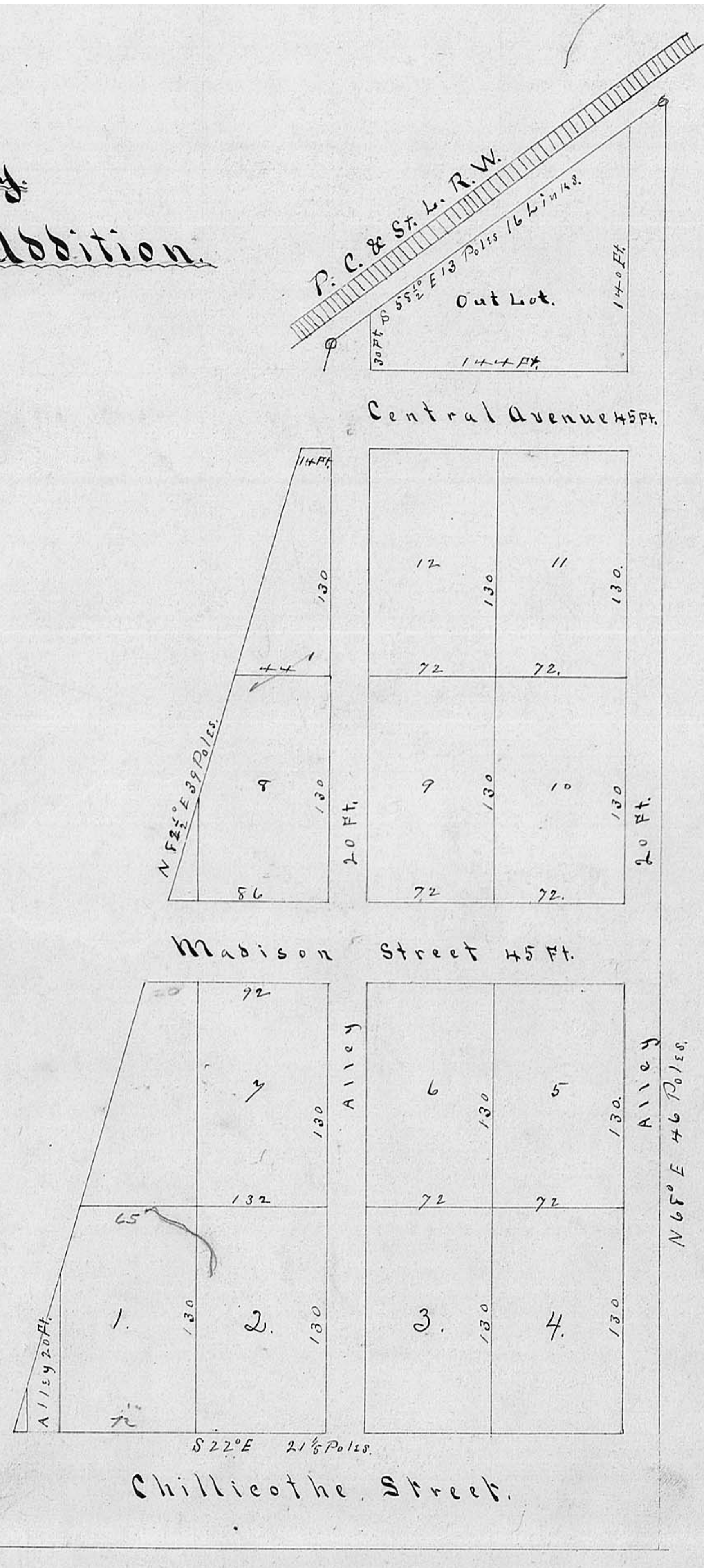

A.H. Sherwoods addition

Sherwoods Addition to the Incorporated Village of Plain City, the survey of which is as follows, to wit,

Beginning at the South West Corner of a tract of land or out Lot owned by the wife of W. P. Andrews: thence N 82 1/2° E 39 poles to a stake: thence S 52 1/2° E along the RR 13 poles + 16 links. thence S 68° W 46 poles to Chillicothe Street. thence W 22° W 2 1/8 poles to the beginning and containing 2.8 acres being a part of Survey No 5125.

Lots No 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 9, 10, 11 and 12, are full lots and each 72 wide by 130 feet deep. Lot No 1 is 72 feet on Chillicothe Street and 65 feet on back end. the fraction added to lot No 7 is 20 feet on Madison Street and 60 feet on back end. Lot No 8 is 86 feet on Madison Street and 44 feet on back end and fraction added to Lot No 8 is 14 feet on Central Avenue and 44 feet on back end. Out Lot adjoining the north alley is 30 feet on said alley 13 poles and 16 links along the line of the R. R. 140 feet along the South alley, and 144 feet front on Central Avenue.
