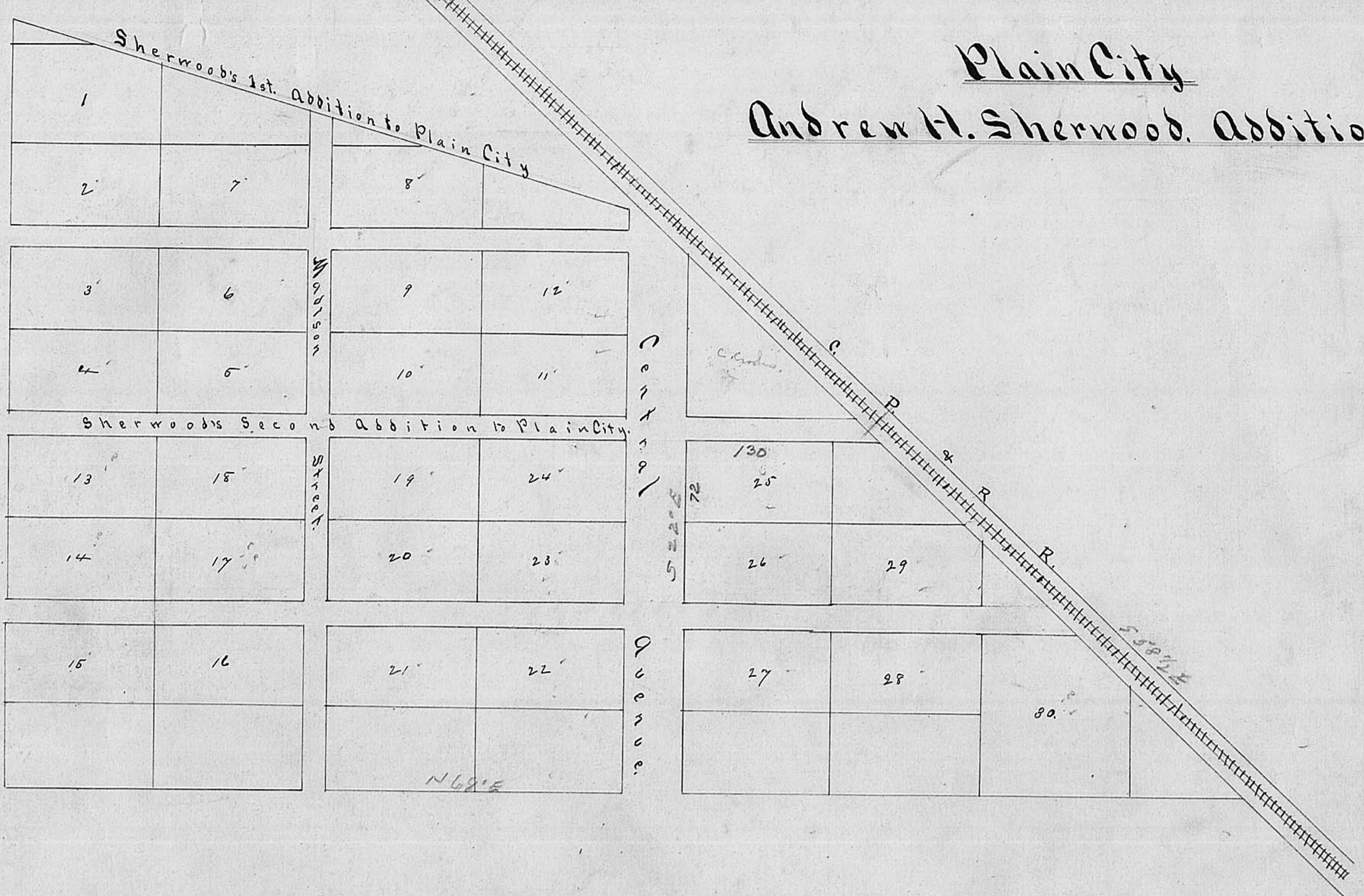

Andrew H. Sherwood addition

Andrew H. Sherwood's Second Addition to Plain City Madison County Ohio. Lot No 1 in First Addition is 88 feet from Stone marked A to South line of said Lot. Lots Nos 2, 3, 4 are each 72 feet front Andrew H. Sherwood's Second Addition to Plain City is predicated upon a Stone at A. (See Plat of Sherwood's First Addition to said Town) Lots No 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28 are each 72 feet front by 130 feet deep Lot No 29 the N.E. corner is cut off by the 50 feet owned by R. R. Lot No 30 is 130 feet on South line and the N line is 73 feet and 83 feet along the side of R. R. and the E line of said Lot is only 10 feet the fraction east of Lot No 25. its W line is 72 feet. N line 42 feet R. R. line 101 feet South line 114 feet and the fraction East of 29. W line 55 feet R. R. line 76 feet South line 54 feet. Madison Street & Central Avenue are each 50 feet wide, all the Alleys are 20 feet.

Know all men by these presents, that Andrew H. Sherwood & Irena Sherwood have adopted the above plat of Lots Streets and alleys caused to be laid off by said A. H. Sherwood under the name of A. H. Sherwood's Second addition to Plain City in the County of Madison in the State of Ohio, and numbered the same for record in the proper office by dedicating to public use the streets and alleys therein set forth acknowledged the same to be their free act and deed for the uses and purposes therein set forth, witness our hands and seals this 31st day of July 1873.
