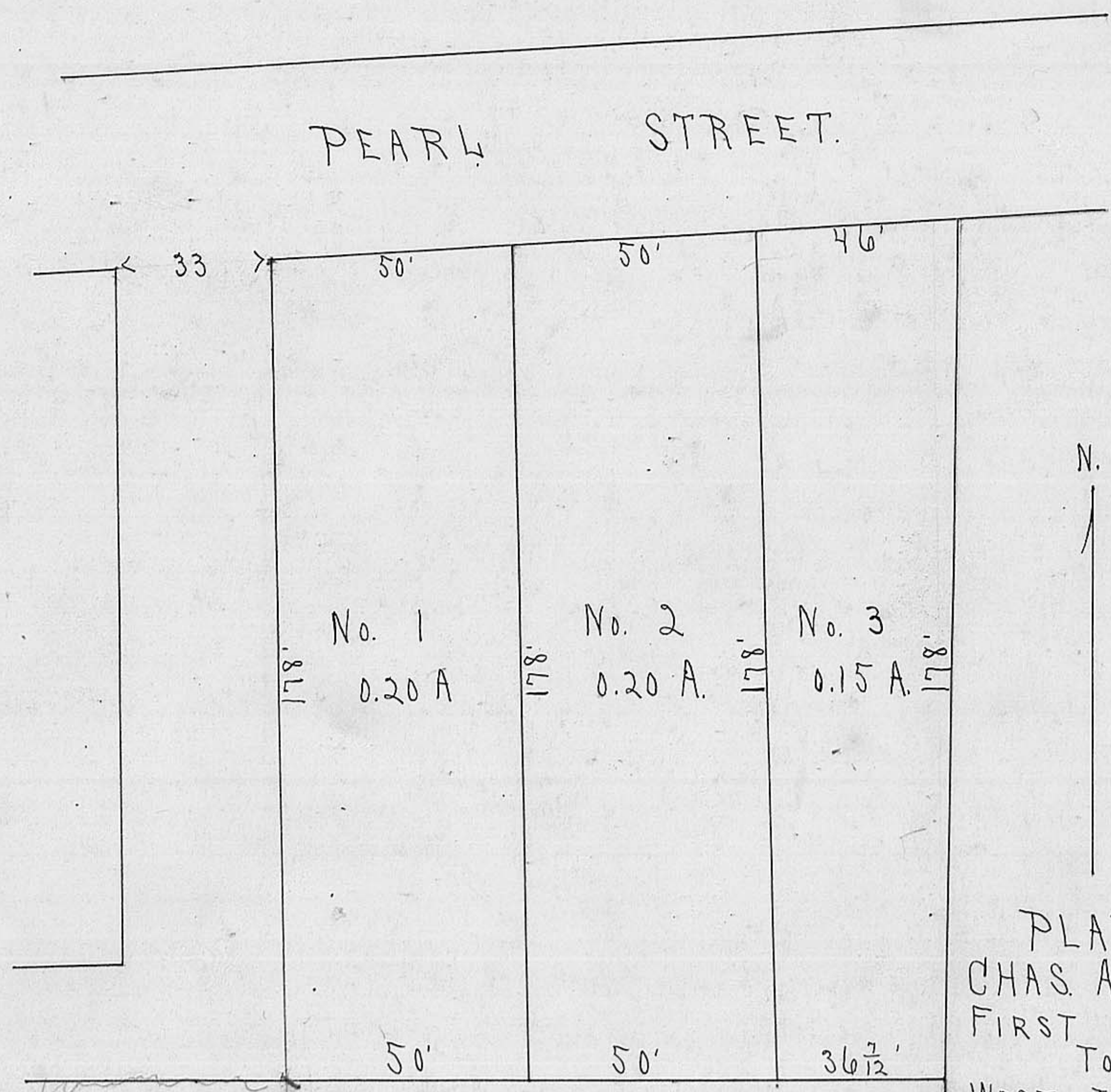


Chas. A. Smith's 1st addition to the Town of Jefferson.

Chas. A. Smith's 1st addition.

London, Ohio, April 4<sup>th</sup> 1904.

At the instance of Chas. A. Smith and Anna Smith I have surveyed the following described tract of land.

Beginning at a stake at the southeast corner of a 33 foot street and up the north line of a 2<sup>4</sup>/<sub>100</sub> acre tract of land sold by H. S. Quinn Executor of America Reddick to John Renner; thence with said line N. 86° 20' E. 2.07 chains (chain 4 poles) to a stake in the mill race north east corner to said Renner; thence N. 0° 45' E. 2.58 chains to a stake near a large burr oak and in the south line of Pearl Street; thence with said line S. 86° 20' W. 2.21 chains to a stake; thence with the east line of said 33 foot street S. 1° 30' E. 2.58 chains to the beginning, containing 0.55 acres. Survey No. 2836 Incorporation of West Jefferson, Madison County, Ohio.

I have also divided the same into three lots as follows: Lots 1 & 2 fronting on Pearl Street and being each 50 feet wide and 178 feet deep; lot No. 3 being 46 feet wide on Pearl Street, 36<sup>7</sup>/<sub>12</sub> feet wide on the Renner line and 178 feet deep.

The said lots are to be known as Chas. A. Smith's 1st Addition to the town of Jefferson, Madison County Ohio.

I certify the above report and accompanying plat to be a correct representation of the survey made by me.
