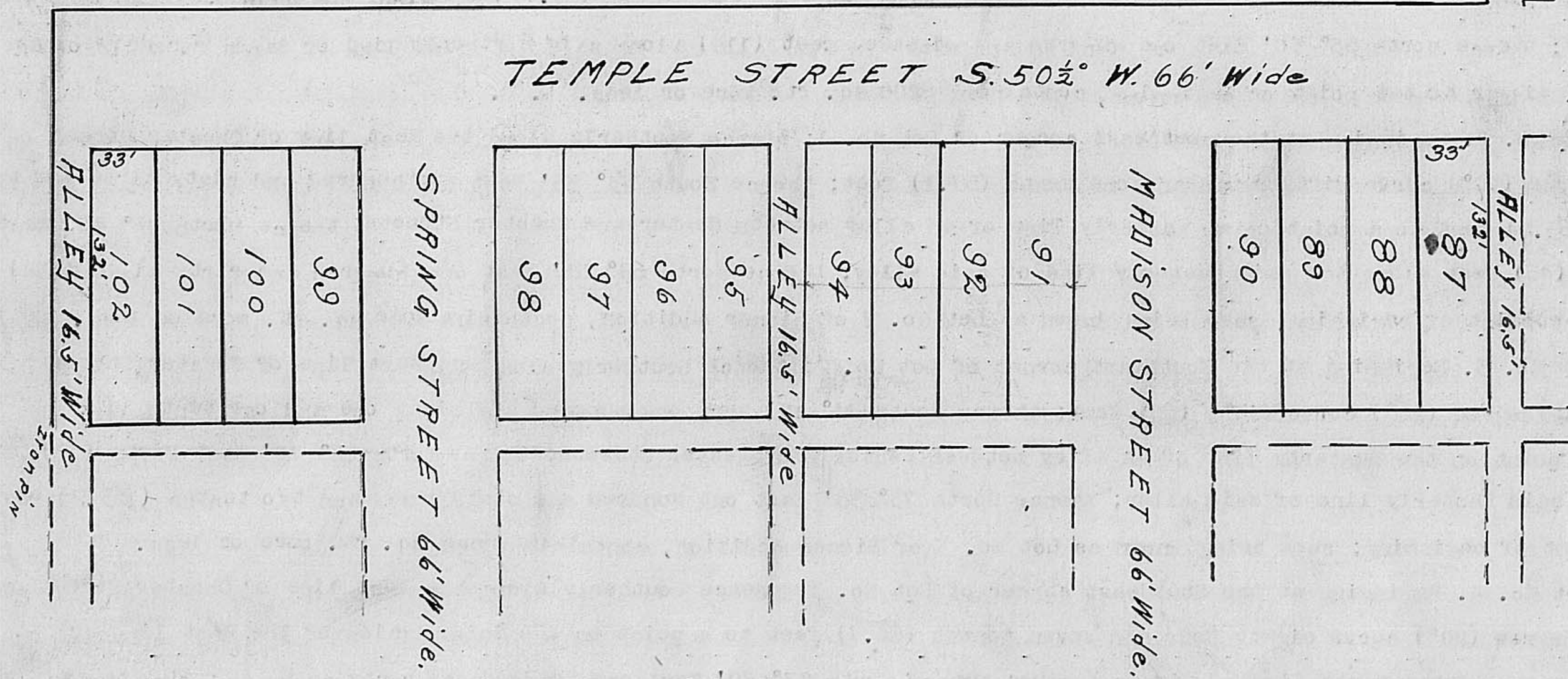


PLAT

Mt. Sterling

Tarbill Addition.

At the request of C. E. Tarbill, I have surveyed and laid out an addition to the Village of Mt. Sterling, Ohio, and to be known as the Tarbill addition to said village.

Beginning at an iron stake in the west line of the Alkire-Tarbill West Side Addition to the Village of Mt. Sterling, Ohio, and corner to a lot of 2.43 acres sold to John O'Day; thence with the north side of said addition N. 50 1/2° E. 10.50 chains to an iron stake 16 1/2 feet from the northeast corner of Lot No. 41 in said addition; thence N. 39 1/2° W. 3 chains to the north side of Temple Street; thence S. 50 1/2° W. 10.50 chains to a stake; thence S. 39 1/2° E. 3 chains to the beginning, containing 3.75 acres of land, more or less, and in the corporation of Mt. Sterling, Ohio.

I then laid out and extended Temple Street S. 50 1/2° W. 10.50 chains in length and 66 feet wide.

I then laid out all alleys 16 1/2 feet wide.

I then laid out sixteen lots numbered, 87, 88, 89, 90, 91, 92, 93, 94, 95, 96, 97, 98, 99, 101, 101, 102, each lot fronts 33 feet on Temple Street and extends back 132 feet deep.

I hereby certify that the above is correct.
