Robert Thomas, Addition.

Robert Thomas addition to California lying on the south side of Main Street and east side of the Kionsville road and consisting of Lots Nos 39, 40, 48, 49, 50 and 51 each 4 poles front by 10 poles deep. Lot No 52, 5 poles long $3\frac{4}{10}$ poles wide at one end and $4\frac{1}{6}$ poles wide at the other end. Lot No 53, 10 poles long $2\frac{1}{3}$ poles wide at one end and $3\frac{1}{2}$ poles wide at the other and four alleys each one pole wide.

Personally appeared before me J. L. Lotspiech a justice of the peace in and for the County aforesaid, Robert Thomas of said County and acknowledged the above plat embracing Lots Nos 39, 40, 48, 49, 50 and 51 each embracing 4 poles front by 10 poles deep Lot 52, 5 poles long $3\frac{4}{10}$ poles wide at one end and $4\frac{1}{6}$ poles wide at the other, and Lot No 53, 10 poles long $2\frac{1}{3}$ poles at one end and $3\frac{1}{2}$ poles wide at the other and 4 alleys each 1 pole wide, to be his addition to the Town of California in said County and in the Township of Fairfield.
