



Midway Wards Addition

Wards addition to the Town of Midway Madison County Ohio. Main Street is 60 feet in width and runs South 2. East. East Street is 60 feet in width. Alleys are 16 1/2 feet in width Lots 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 40 & 41 are four poles in front and 5 1/2 poles back and front on main street all the other Lots are 4 poles in front and 5 poles back Except 24 & 27 which are 4 1/2 poles in front numbered (in continuation of the Lots in said Town of Midway) from 24 to 41 inclusive the North side of the above plat binds on the South side of the Federal road the Survey of the aforesaid addition is predicated on a Stone which by my direction has been planted at the Northeast corner of Lot No 29 which said Stone is North 2 & 4 poles from the South East corner of Lot No 1 in said Town of Midway. I hereby certify that the above plat is a correct representation of Wards addition to the Town of Midway and that the demarcations of the Lots, Streets and Alley are correct as above stated.
