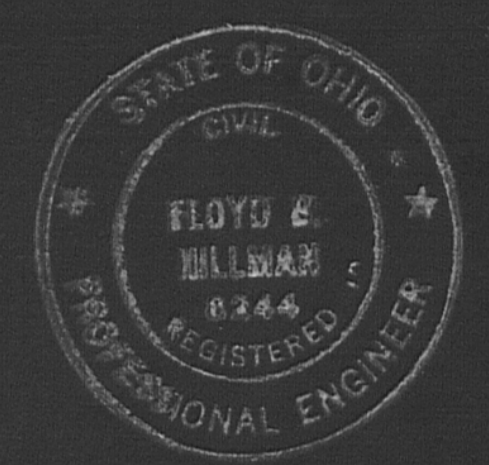


SURVEY OF

**TRACT ONE (144/677):**

situated in the County

of Madison in the State of Ohio, and in the Township of Paint and bounded and described as follows:

Beginning in the center of the London-Washington C. H. Road ( State Route No. 38) at the N. W. corner of the Henry Tract; thence along said Henry north line N. 80° 22' E. 300 feet; thence N. 17° 30' W. 80 feet; thence S. 80° 22' W. 300 feet to the center of said road; thence S. 17° 30' E. 80 feet to the place of beginning, containing 0.55 acres, more or less, subject to a certain highway easement. Being part of V.M.S. No. 4387, and also being part of the land conveyed to Thomas F. Wood by warranty deed from Alve Evans et al., as shown in Vol. 144 page 323, Madison County Deed Record.

Being Tract 1 of survey of part of T. F. Wood farm, a plat thereof being recorded in Plat Book 1 page 310, Madison County Recorder's Office at London, Ohio.

**TRACTS TWO & THREE (148/641):**

situated

in the County of Madison in the State of Ohio, and in the Township of Paint, and bounded and described as follows:

Being Tract No. 2 and Tract No. 3 of the survey of part of T.F. Wood farm in Paint Township, Madison County, Ohio as said tracts are numbered, delineated and described upon the recorded plat of said survey in Plat Book 1, page 310, Madison County, Recorder's Office.

Said tracts are more particularly described as follows:

**TRACT TWO:**

Situated in Paint Township, Madison County, Ohio, and being part of V.M.S. 4387 and described as follows: Beginning in the center of the London-Washington C.H. Road at a point which bears N. 17° 30' W. a distance of 80.0 feet from the NW corner of the Henry Tract; thence N. 80° 22' E. a distance of 300 feet; thence N. 17° 30' W. a distance of 88.9 feet; thence S. 80° 22' W. a distance of 300.0 feet to the center of said road thence S. 17° 30' E. a distance of 88.9 feet to the place of beginning, containing 0.61 acres subject to a certain highway easement. This land being a part of the land conveyed to Thom. Wood by warranty deed from Evans et. al. as shown in Deed Record Vol. 144, page 323.

**TRACT THREE:**

Situated in Paint Township, Madison County, Ohio and being part of V.M.S. 4387 and described as follows: Beginning in the center of the London-Washington C.H. Road at a point which bears N 17° 30' W. a distance of 168.9 feet from the NW corner of the Henry Tract, thence N. 80° 22' E a distance of 300 feet; thence N. 17° 30' W. a distance of 88.9 feet; thence S. 80° 22' W. a distance of 300 feet to the center of said road; thence S. 17° 30' E. a distance of 88.9 feet to the beginning. Containing 0.61 acres subject to all legal highways. The above land being part of the land conveyed to Thom. Wood by Evans et. al. by warranty deed as shown in Deed Record Vol. 144, page 320.

**TRACT FOUR (144/645):**

situated in the County

of Madison in the State of Ohio, and in the Township of Paint and bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the center line of the London-Washington C. H. road (State Route 38) which bears S. 3° 18' W. 480 feet from the Northwest corner of the Thomas F. Wood 82.58 acre tract; thence N. 87° 16' E. 350.0 feet; thence S. 16° 57' E. 224.68 feet; thence S. 79° 20' W. 350 feet to the center of said road thence N. 17° 30' W. 242.8 feet; thence N. 3° 18' E. 31.5 feet to the beginning. Containing 2.00 acres subject to certain highway easements.

The above described land being part of that conveyed to Thomas F. Wood by warranty deed from Evans et al, recorded in Volume 144, page 323 of the Recorder's Office, Madison County, Ohio.
